


## Tech Tip #42: ProDOC Packages Option is Missing

\*If you do not see the Packages option on the ProDOC menu, please contact your system Administrator before adding it by following the steps below.\*

Right-clicking on the ProDOC icon opens the Options menu (shown below). Some of the settings listed in the Options menu, including *Packages*, can be enabled or disabled in the ProDOC.ini settings file.



Enabling *Packages* is very easy and can be done by following these steps:

1. Open the following path using windows file explorer:

## C:\RDI\_Work\Priv\_PDoc

- 2. Open the ProDoc.ini file
- 3. Search for "Packages"
- 4. Update the line to read "Packages=1"

Close and relaunch ProDOC. This will update the ProDOC menu to include the *Packages* option.
